

Pipelineers Podcast Recording Process

To simplify recording over the internet Pipelineers Podcast uses a service called ZenCastr. ZenCastr allows high quality recording without our guests having to manage the recording process on their end. For technical reasons, ZenCastr uses the Google Chrome web browser. You can safely download and install Chrome here:

NOTE: You do **not** need to make Chrome your default browser.

Setting up for the Recording

1. If you have not connected the provided microphone and headphones that we sent you do so now following those instructions.
2. Copy the link in the e-mail we sent you for your episode into the address bar at the top of the Chrome browser.
3. ZenCastr will prompt you to give a name to identify yourself for the recording. Enter your name.
4. You will be presented with a small pop-up window allowing you to select which microphone you want to use for the recording. Select the AT.
5. The microphone in the box next to your name will show your audio input. When you talk into the mic you will see a blue line representing your audio. Once the recording begins you will also see a green waveform scrolling through the window as the recording progresses.

During the Recording

You don't need to do anything except enjoy the conversation!

After the recording

Zencastr records your voice locally and will process and upload it once the recording is done. Please do not turn off your computer or close the Zencastr window until this is done. It should only take a few minutes and you do not have to do anything else. There is a progress meter to let you know when it's done.
